### **Train Services to London Bridge to Improve**

The Forest Hill Society has been pressing for an increase in Southern services to London Bridge since they were cut to just two per hour after Covid. Since then services on the Windrush (Overground) line have been getting very busy with commuters avoiding services from London Bridge due to half-hourly gaps in the services.

After much insistence, we discovered that the December 2024 timetable changes will bring back Southern services in the morning and evening peaks, returning us to four trains per hour between London Bridge and Norwood Junction where you can interchange for services to Surrey and Sussex.

There had been rumours that Overground might extend services to London Bridge, however, with the planned increase in South Services, it looks like Windrush trains will not be going to London Bridge regularly any time soon, BUT ...

There will be a SPECIAL, one-off Overground service between Crystal Palace and London Bridge Easter Sunday, 31st March 2024. Some members of the Forest Hill Society will be taking this unique opportunity to travel this route, and
