You Said, We Listened, We Did

Several local residents from Sunderland Road, Perry Vale have reported a suspected brothel in their road giving them cause for concern with the related anti-social behavior (ASB). Forest Hill SNT have assisted their colleagues from Perry Vale in tackling this issue over the last month and have stopped the immediate ASB and are now working with the Local Authority and other agencies to tackle the longer term associated issues.

Complaints of delivery bikes from a fast-food outlet in London Road driving recklessly across pavements have been reported by members of the public to the SNT. We've identified the offenders and issued an 'Acceptable Behaviour Contract' with the company tying them into prosecution should their employees breach the conditions.

Good News Story

One evening just after Christmas officers attended an incident where local residents had reported suspects trying to force entry to block of flats. As they arrived a number of youths attempted to run away but were pursued, stopped and subsequently searched.

Two of those stopped were dealt with for possession of drugs and another was arrested for having a large kitchen knife concealed in his clothing.

Crime prevention advice

Most vehicle crime is opportunistic and therefore preventable. By following some straightforward advice, and working together, we can ensure that this type of crime keeps falling. Criminals steal number plates to try and help them avoid being caught committing crimes and to try and sell stolen vehicles to get legitimate ones.

Number plates can be secured by screws, which can be purchased from Halfords. These screws, known as 'Clutch Head Screws' hold the number plates on and do not allow thieves to get the number plates off without them breaking. This in itself is a deterrent.
